ABOUT THE FESTIVAL

"In September, horror invades the city of Lisbon. MOTELX - Lisbon International Horror Film Festival has been the trademark for the best international and emerging Portuguese genre cinema in the Portuguese capital since 2007.

Prestigious guests such as George A. Romero, Stuart Gordon, John Landis, Coffin Joe, Asia and Dario Argento, Tobe Hooper, Hideo Nakata, Eli Roth, Brian Yuzna, Alejandro Jodorowsky, Roger Corman, Xan Cassavettes or Ari Aster have already joined the nearly 20,000 people who annually pass by the iconic Cinema São Jorge, the Festival's main venue, located in the heart of Lisbon.

MOTELX is a member of the Méliès International Festivals Federation (MIFF), a federation that includes 25 festivals from 19 different countries and accounts for an audience of 800,000 people, and part of the Europe for festivals, Festivals for Europe (EFFE) community, allowing it to promote European and, in particular, Portuguese genre films at a wider range. The Festival welcomes up and coming and established directors, who come to showcase their love for horror cinema. The Best Portuguese Horror Short Film Award prompts many to work for the sole purpose of participating in the competition, which opens the possibility to enter the Méliès d'or competition organised by the MIFF. It also includes the Méliès d'argent for Best European Feature Film and Best European Short Film, an Audience Award for the Festival's Room Service section, and a microSHORTS Award for films up to 2 minutes entirely made with a mobile phone, tablet, or webcam.

MOTELX also has an educational approach by partnering with the Portuguese Cinematheque to explore and unearth lost gems of Portuguese genre cinema for its Lost Room section, and with MOTELX Lab, a section dedicated to workshops, masterclasses and talks with national and international professionals related to the cinematographic art. It also welcomes children in the Big Bad Wolf section and regularly promotes open-air events, leaving its mark in several prominent locations of the city of Lisbon. Since 2017, it further increases its reach with an annual world tour of several films that have screened at the Festival."
